Introduction

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the use of video chat between students and teachers has become a new normal. Students will write an explanatory essay describing how to utilize video chat to conference with their teachers.

Learning Objectives

Procedure

- 1. Introduce the topic by discussing how the COVID-19 pandemic has forced teachers and students to use video chat to communicate.
- 2. Have the students complete an individual flow map outlining how to use video chat to communicate with their teachers.
- 3. Pair students with a partner to discuss their flow map.
- 4. The students are to use their flow maps to compose their essay.

Writing Prompt: The COVID-19 pandemic has forced many school closures and increased virtual learning. Teachers and students have had to rely on technology to communicate with each other while schools are closed. Write an explanatory essay explaining how to use video chat to meet with your teacher during virtual learning days.
